Dixiemix Jazz Band

DixieMix was formed in 2006 and celebrated their 17th Anniversary in November 2023. DixieMix Jazz Band, led by Simon Nelson on trumpet and flugel horn rapidly established itself as one of the UK's most engaging and hard working jazz ensembles.

The band brings together the best jazz musicians in the south east. Their talent, knowledge and enthusiasm for traditional jazz combines with ease to provide outstanding entertainment for all occasions. With emphasis always on first class music mixed with great humour, this band never fails to provide a top quality performance.

The band is a professional six piece excelling with fresh arrangements of many jazz favourites old and new all with the DixieMix twist. Our enthusiastic approach has helped the band gain national recognition, leading to a tour with Rod Stewart, TV appearances and multiple festival and theatre gigs.



An Oscar for Ella

When Oscar Peterson and Ella Fitzgerald first met for 'Jazz at the Philharmonic' they found they were a natural pairing, and a legend was born. Oscar and Ella worked together from the 1950's to 1980's recording many times and performing many concerts together. The Jake Leg Jug Band bring you the authentic sounds of 1920's and 30's America - jazz, blues, ragtime and gospel. Songs of murder, betrayal, gambling, liquor and redemption.

After self-releasing their debut album Cotton Mouth, the band signed to one of the UK's most prestigious Jazz labels, recording three albums as part of the 'Vintage Recording Project', recording live around ribbon microphones, as it would have been back in the 1930's. Facilities at the Langstone Cliff Hotel



The fully licensed Lincoln Bar currently has a choice of six draught beers, lagers and ciders, wine by the glass, cocktails and soft drinks. Boasting a warm, cosy fireplace, this is the perfect place for a pre-dinner drink. We also offer a wide range of hot drinks including fruit teas, hot chocolate and Italian espresso coffees.

The Lounge, Drawing Room and Verandah Room are three interconnecting rooms overlooking spectacular sea views across the hotel lawns towards the Exe Estuary and English Channel. With photographs of the grounds and local area they are the perfect place to sit back and relax.



The Indoor Swimming Pool is approximately 10 metres long by 6 metres wide and is approximately 1 metre at the shallow end falling to approximately 1.5 metres at the deep end. The indoor paddling pool is approximately 3 metres square and 400mm deep. We like to keep our Indoor pool heated to around 30°Celsius. The Indoor Swimming Pool is normally open between 7.00am and 7.00pm for hotel residents.

The Langstone Cliff Hotel (owned and managed by the Rogers family since 1946 no less!) is situated perfectly on the South Devon Coast, twelve miles from both Exeter and Torbay and seven miles from the M5 motorway.

The 64 en-suite bedrooms are all equipped to a high standard. Many have balconies and sea views. The hotel is spacious with a choice of Lounges and Bars, an air conditioned Restaurant and a magnificent ballroom. It is set in almost 20 acres of Devon woodland with large lawns overlooking the sea and has a footpath leading to the beaches just 500 metres away. A further 300 metres, adjoining the beach, is an Internationally renowned bird sanctuary and an 18-hole links golf course.



Leisure facilities include indoor and outdoor pools, hard tennis court, full size snooker table, table tennis, fitness room, hairdressing salon, toddler room and play centre. Leave the M5 by junction 30 onto the A379 road to Dawlish (9 miles) and turn left by the small harbour, half a mile after the village of Starcross, Once you are in Dawlish Warren, the road turns right up the hill. The Langstone Cliff Hotel is on the left.

Rail Travellers - book to Dawlish. The station is two miles from the hotel and has a taxi rank.
